

Getting there driving

Travelling from Dublin:

Proceed along the Athlone bypass crossing the River Shannon and pass the N61 exit to Roscommon and Sligo. Exit the N6 at Monksland for the R 326. Turn right at the T-junction and cross the bridge over the N6. Pass Elan Pharmaceuticals on your left and just a half a mile after on your left hand side is the Hotel.

Travelling from Galway:

Exit the N6 on the outskirts of Athlone for the N362. Turn left onto the N362 at the T-junction. Pass Elan Pharmaceuticals on your left and just a half a mile after on your left hand side is the Hotel.

Travelling from the North via (LONGFORD/MONAGHAN/DUNDALK)

Approaching Athlone from the North, take the N54 and the N3 on the Cavan bypass then take the N55 signposted Athlone which comes through Edgewardstown and Ballymahon. Continue towards the Town Centre and take the dual carriageway towards Galway. Take the exit signposted for the Athlone Springs Hotel.

Travelling from the South via (LIMERICK/CORK)

Approaching Athlone from the South, N52 coming through Nenagh town and N62 coming from Birr through Ferbane, you will merge with the N6 5 kilometres outside the town. Proceed to join the dual carriageway at the eastern end. Travel the dual carriageway bound for Galway. Take the exit signposted for the Athlone Springs Hotel.

Travelling from the NORTH - WEST (SLIGO/ BALLYBOFEY/ DERRY)

Approaching Athlone on the Roscommon road N61, join the dual carriageway on the right after the Ganly roundabout, bound for Galway. Take the exit before the over head bridge for Tuam signposted for the Athlone Springs Hotel.
