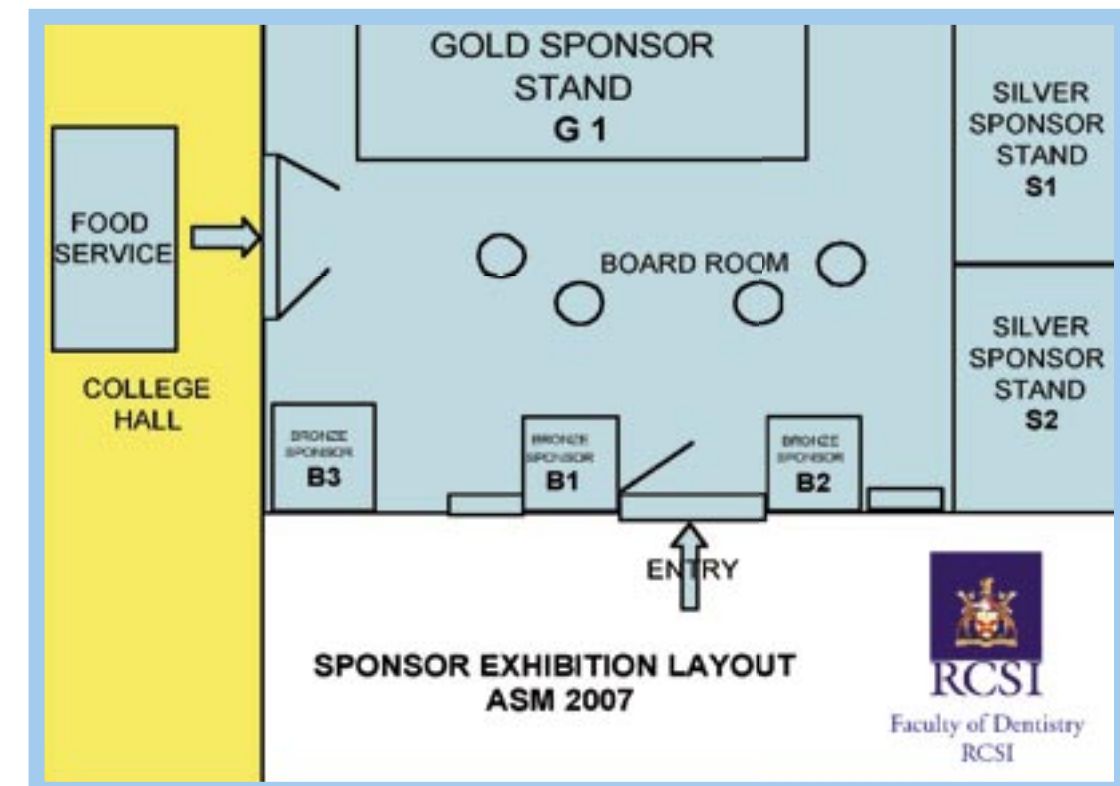

THE SPEAKERS

Dr P F Allen	Dr Finbarr Allen is Head of University Dental School and Hospital, Cork and is a Senior Lecturer/Consultant in Restorative Dentistry. He has been Chairman of the Restorative Dentistry Advisory Committee in Ireland since 2004. His clinical interests are in prosthodontics and restorative treatment of the elderly patient.
Dr J Besford	'Dr John Besford was drawn to dentures at dental school (arrested development: playing with wax, colouring in RPD designs, etc.). Only later did he learn from his patients the spiritually healing, life-enhancing potential of restoring facial and dental appearances ruined by destructive dentistry.'
Dr F M Burke	Dr Francis Burke, Senior Lecturer/Consultant in Restorative Dentistry, University Dental School and Hospital, Cork. He is Past President of the British Society for Gerodontology. He is a member of the Board of the Faculty of Dentistry RCSI and is the Scientific Chairman for this meeting.
Dr T Clifford	Dr Thomas J Clifford qualified from Queens University Belfast in 1972 and has been Senior Lecturer and Consultant in prosthetics at the School of Dentistry Queen's University Belfast since 1982.
Prof N Creugers	Professor Nico Creugers graduated from University of Nijmegen, obtaining his PhD from the same university in 1986. He was in private practice in Arhem until he was appointed professor in 1994. He is the chairman of the Department of Oral Function and Prosthetic Dentistry of the Radboud University Nijmegen and has been director of education of the Dental College since 2002.
Dr C Irwin	Dr Chris Irwin is a Consultant in Restorative Dentistry, Royal Group of Hospitals Trust, Belfast and a Reader in Periodontology in Queen's University. Dr Irwin combines a referral-based clinical practice with research into the pathogenesis and treatment of periodontal disease.
Mr G Kearns	Mr Gerard Kearns is a Consultant Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon, Mid Western Regional Hospital, Limerick. He is a medical and dental graduate of Trinity College Dublin and undertook Post Graduate Residency and Fellowship Training in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the University of California San Francisco, Massachusetts General Hospital and Harvard Dental School Boston.
Dr M Kelleher	Dr Martin Kelleher is a Consultant in Restorative Dentistry at Kings College London Dental Institute where he is post graduate dental tutor. He is Past President of the British Society for Restorative Dentistry and chairs the Dental Claims Advisory Board of Dental Protection. He is in private practice in Bromley.
Prof M McMurdo	Professor Marion McMurdo is Head of Ageing and Health at the University of Dundee. She leads a research team focussing on the effects of exercise and nutrition in the prevention of disability in later life.
Dr P Moynihan	Dr Paula Moynihan is a Reader in Nutrition and Oral Health and Director of the World Health Organization Collaborating Centre for Nutrition and Oral Health in the School of Dental Sciences, Newcastle University. She is a Registered Public Health Nutritionist and Dietitian.
Dr A Nolan	Dr. Anita Nolan, Consultant/Senior Lecturer in Oral Medicine at Dundee Dental Hospital & School, Scotland. As well as teaching and clinical service, her research interests include Orofacial Granulomatosis, Sjogren's Syndrome & immunosuppression and the oral mucosa.
Dr F Quinn	Dr Frank Quinn is a Consultant in Restorative Dentistry at Dublin Dental School and Hospital, Trinity College Dublin. He co-ordinates training in "Basic Dental Care" in the undergraduate dental programme, and is involved in teaching and research in the clinical applications and durability of dental materials. He is a member of the Board of the Faculty of Dentistry RCSI, and currently serves as its Honorary Secretary.
Dr E Saunders	Dr Elizabeth Saunders was a Clinical Senior Lecturer and Consultant in Endodontics at Dundee Dental School, until recently. A Past President of the British Endodontic Society she is now in part-time endodontic private practice in Edinburgh.
